Financial reports

Highlights:

- Operating Expenses
 - Sustaining membership revenue is down 10%
 - Recruitment of new members has been down.
 - Since FY24 Fall Drive
- Waiting for input on CSG
- CPB restricted programming intended for a national audience
 - Content offered outside local broadcast area
 - Waterfront Blues Festival
 - Native Voice Network
 - Democracy Now
- Danielle doesn't feel that what is pledged is less than planned
- Decision making about Development revenues to come next month
- Operating Expenses
 - o Down by \$50,000

Equipment and Facilities Projects

- UPS is now fully installed
- Additional updates next month

Accounts Payable

- What needs to be paid this month
- Does not include the 401K make whole payment
- When will we need to transfer money into the OnPoint operating account
 - Currently \$18,000 at the end of March
 - o Danielle is nervous about \$30,000 or lower
 - \$50,000 during a payroll week
- Monthly burn rate hovers around \$80,000 could reach \$100,000 depending on expenses during a given month

Variance report

- Revenues \$9000 from Fall came in September
 - Successful Fall Drive
 - 1 extra mailer instead of a renewal letter
 - RevOps looking at opportunities for sustaining membership going back over the past few years
- Contracts
 - KBOO is now out of public storage
 - o Telephone
 - Rent
- Pensions are deferred
- Computers and tech are deferred
- Dues and licensing
 - Budget created based on when bills are paid
 - Should go into prepaid and expenses each month
 - o Danielle will review prepaids

Grants

- KBOO did not receive the OCF grant
 - o \$40,000
- Next grant to fear back on
 - PGE Grant to support the Youth Collective
- Next grant application

- o 99 Girlfriends
 - Application 4/1

Cash Balances

- Advantis CD \$255,000
- OCCU CD in August for \$255,000
- OnPoint \$60,000 on 2/29
- Stocks \$12,000 to sell immediately
- Paypal \$3,000 on 2/29
- Rivermark money market \$214,000

Oregon Wildlife Federation

- Joe Keeting shuttered his nonprofit and gave assets to KBOO
 - Nathan accepted a check for \$7,700
- Emma asked what we are doing to memorialize gifts like this on the air?
 - o Nathan will work with James Neale on a program to include the Marsh Trust
 - Arty is working to recognize legacy gifts
 - Move conversation to Development Committee
